The terms of this agreement are as follows:

- 1. All items offered for sale must be Native American Indian related. You are allowed to sell ONLY QUALITY items that do not demean the craftsmanship, pride, or customs of Native America Indians. NO Flea Market or mass produced items will be allowed – NO Exceptions! Note: It is your responsibility to be in full compliance with the U.S. Federal Public Law 101-644, known as the “Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990.”**
- 2. You are responsible for any vendor permits and sales taxes that may be required by state or local government authorities.**
- 3. Placement for set-up shall be as directed and approved by the designated event representative.**
- 4. You assume all responsibility for the safety and security of your items, goods, trading area, equipment, and vehicles at all times.**
- 5. Only one vehicle will be allowed in the general trading area, all other vehicles shall be parked in the general parking area or as directed.**
- 6. No electrical or water hook-ups will be provided. The use of electrical generators (at the outdoor events) between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. is prohibited.**
- 7. The event will take place regardless of weather conditions.**
- 8. You are required to maintain your sales and setup area in a neat and clean manner at all times. All debris and trash shall be removed and disposed of each day and the site shall be thoroughly cleaned following the conclusion of the event.**
- 9. No substitute artisans - vendors will be allowed to fulfill this agreement for you.**
- 10. The use or sale of drugs and or alcoholic beverages or products is strictly prohibited.**
- 11. You are Not Allowed to sell Food or Beverages, unless specifically agreed to do so.**
- 12. The sale of any taxable Tobacco Goods such as Cigarettes, Cigars, etc. are also prohibited.**

The federal Public Law 101-644, commonly known as the "Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990" provides for criminal penalty for the misrepresentation of Indian produced goods and products. Section 104 of this law states "It is unlawful to offer or display for sale or sell any good, with or without a Government trademark, in a manner that falsely suggests it is Indian-produced, an Indian product, or the product of a particular Indian or Indian tribe or Indian arts and crafts organization resident within the United States." It is a criminal offense for someone knowingly to violate the law.
